WEEK 13 GOLF LEAGUE NOTES

This week is the last week of the 2nd half, and it looks like Mike has it all wrapped up again. Although Steve is not mathematically eliminated yet, he needs to take 6 points and Mike needs to get shut out. Even if Steve golfs very well and Mike blows it, we've only had 6 "in the money" golfers 2 times this half. Looks like Mike will be going for his 3rd consecutive championship.

I've been looking at the scores and thinking about how to better represent everyone's average. None of us are pros so we all go through inconsistent periods of time, which can skew our averages. For example, Jeff in the first half and Mike in the second half this year. I think it might be better to keep a rolling average of 12 scores and drop the highest 4 in order to get a more consistent average going. The rolling average would pull scores back from previous seasons, unless that golfer didn't have any previous seasons. I have all the data to do it, but I'll have to review in greater detail to see what the effect is.

Finally, Bill dropped a score last week with Jay to follow after this week.
