Proposed TRI-V Club By-Law change to Article IV, Item 2.

Article IV, Item 2 currently reads:

All members eligible to vote may cast a vote by absentee ballot. It is the responsibility of the member to request an absentee ballot.

Proposed change to Article IV, item 2:

All members eligible to vote and unable to attend the March meeting may cast their vote by absentee ballot. It is the responsibility of the member to request an absentee ballot from the election committee. He may request to receive the ballot electronically or by U.S. mail. It is the member's responsibility to return the ballot to the election committee by Email, U.S. mail or by hand, not verbally or by text message.
